A draw is a fight that went the distance and no clear cut winner was declared based on scoring by the judges and so the fight then is declared a draw. A no contest is different usually when you don't have a fight that goes the distance and is stopped before its completion and no clear winner is declared.

A No Contest is usually called if a fight ends in unusual circumstances, such as the the recent Chad Dawson v Bernard Hopkins fight, in the 2nd round Hopkins was dropped onto his shoulder in an accidental clash with Dawson, and Hopkins wasn't able to continue.
